Mr. REID introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the design, planning, and construction of the Truckee watershed reclamation project for the reclamation and reuse of water.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRUCKEE WATERSHED RECLAMATION**
4 **PROJECT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and
6 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (43 U.S.C. 390h
7 et seq.) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting after section 1601 the fol-
 2 lowing:

3 **“Subtitle A—Specific Projects”;**

4 (2) by redesignating sections 1631, 1632, 1633,
 5 and 1634 (43 U.S.C. 390h–13, 390h–14, 390h–15,
 6 390h–16) as sections 1633, 1671, 1672, and 1631,
 7 respectively;

8 (3) by moving section 1631 (as redesignated by
 9 paragraph (2)) to follow section 1630;

10 (4) by inserting before section 1671 (as redesign-
 11 nated by paragraph (2)) the following:

12 **“Subtitle B—Studies and**
 13 **Research”;**

14 and

15 (5) by inserting after section 1631 (as redesign-
 16 nated by paragraph (2)) the following:

17 **“SEC. 1632. TRUCKEE WATERSHED RECLAMATION**
 18 **PROJECT.**

19 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-
 20 tion with Washoe County, Nevada, may participate in the
 21 design, planning, and construction of the Truckee water-
 22 shed reclamation project to reclaim and reuse wastewater
 23 (including degraded ground water) within and without the
 24 service area of Washoe County, Nevada.

1 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
2 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed
3 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

4 “(c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary
5 shall not be used for operation or maintenance of the
6 project described in subsection (a).”.

7 **SEC. 2. TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**

8 (a) The Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater
9 Study and Facilities Act is amended—

10 (1) in subsection (a) of section 1633 (43 U.S.C.
11 390h–13) (as redesignated by section 1(a)(2)), by
12 striking “1630” and inserting “1632”;

13 (2) in section 1671(c) (43 U.S.C. 390h–14(c))
14 (as redesignated by section 1(a)(2)), by striking
15 “section 1633” and inserting “section 1672”; and

16 (3) in section 1672 (43 U.S.C. 390h–15) (as
17 redesignated by section 1(a)(2))—

18 (A) in the section heading, by inserting
19 **“FOR GROUNDWATER STUDY”** before the pe-
20 riod; and

21 (B) by striking “section 1632” and insert-
22 ing “section 1671”.

23 (b) The table of contents in section 2 of the Reclama-
24 tion Projects Authorization and Adjustment Act of 1992
25 (43 U.S.C. prec. 371; Public Law 102–575) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting after the item relating to sec-
 2 tion 1601 the following:

“Subtitle A—Specific Projects”;

3 and

4 (2) by striking the items relating to sections
 5 1631 through 1634 and inserting the following:

“Sec. 1631. Willow Lake Natural Treatment System Project.

“Sec. 1632. Truckee Watershed Reclamation Project.

“Sec. 1633. Authorization of appropriations.

“Subtitle B—Studies and Research

“Sec. 1671. Groundwater study.

“Sec. 1672. Authorization of appropriations for groundwater study.”.
