- 5 (a) Placement of Plaque.—
- 6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Inte-
- 7 rior shall install on the steps of the Lincoln Memo-
- 8 rial in the District of Columbia a suitable plaque to

- commemorate the speech of Martin Luther King,
  Jr., known as the "I Have A Dream" speech.
- 3 (2) EXACT PLACEMENT.—The plaque shall be 4 placed at the location on the steps where Martin Lu-5 ther King, Jr., delivered the "I Have A Dream" 6 speech on August 28, 1963.

## (b) Acceptance of Contributions.—

- (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior may accept contributions to help pay the cost of preparing the plaque and installing the plaque on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial as required by subsection (a).
- (2) Funds for plaque.—Amounts under paragraph (1) shall be credited to the appropriation supporting the maintenance and operation of the Lincoln Memorial.
