## A BILL

To amend the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 to renew the authority of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to indemnify its licensees, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Price-Anderson  
5 Amendments Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. INDEMNIFICATION OF LICENSEES.**

7 Section 170c. of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42  
8 U.S.C. 2210(c)) is amended in the first sentence by strik-  
9 ing “August 1, 2002” and inserting “August 1, 2012”.

1 **SEC. 3. MAXIMUM ANNUAL DEFERRED PREMIUM.**

2 Section 170b.(1) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954  
3 (42 U.S.C. 2210(b)(1)) is amended by striking  
4 “\$10,000,000” and inserting “\$20,000,000”.

5 **SEC. 4. REPORTS TO CONGRESS.**

6 Section 170p.(1) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954  
7 (42 U.S.C. 2210(p)(1)) is amended by striking “August  
8 1, 1998” and inserting “August 1, 2008”.

9 **SEC. 5. APPLICABILITY.**

10 The amendments made by this Act apply with respect  
11 to nuclear incidents occurring on or after the date of en-  
12 actment of this Act.
