A BILL

To reauthorize the Water Resources Research Act of 1984.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE WATER RE-**
4 **SOURCES RESEARCH ACT OF 1984.**

5 Section 104 of the Water Resources Research Act of
6 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (f)(1), by striking “the Sec-
2 retary” and all that follows and inserting “the Sec-
3 retary \$9,000,000 for fiscal year 2001, \$10,000,000
4 for each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and
5 \$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005,
6 to remain available until expended.”; and

7 (2) in the first sentence of subsection (g)(1), by
8 striking “the Secretary of the Interior” and all that
9 follows through “2000” and inserting “the Secretary
10 \$3,000,000 for fiscal year 2001, \$4,000,000 for
11 each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and \$6,000,000
12 for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005, to be avail-
13 able”.
