- 3 SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE WATER RE-
- 4 SOURCES RESEARCH ACT OF 1984.
- 5 Section 104 of the Water Resources Research Act of
- 6 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (f)(1), by striking "the Sec2 retary" and all that follows and inserting "the Sec3 retary \$9,000,000 for fiscal year 2001, \$10,000,000
4 for each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and
5 \$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005,
6 to remain available until expended."; and

(2) in the first sentence of subsection (g)(1), by striking "the Secretary of the Interior" and all that follows through "2000" and inserting "the Secretary \$3,000,000 for fiscal year 2001, \$4,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and \$6,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005, to be available".
