3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mother Teresa Reli-
5 gious Workers Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT AUTHORITY FOR ENTRY INTO UNITED**
2 **STATES OF CERTAIN RELIGIOUS WORKERS.**

3 Section 101(a)(27)(C)(ii) of the Immigration and
4 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(27)(C)(ii)) is amended
5 by striking “before October 1, 2000,” each place it ap-
6 pears.
