1 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF REWARDS PROGRAM TO IN-**
2 **CLUDE RWANDA.**

3 Section 102 of the Act of October 30, 1998 (Public
4 Law 105–323) is amended—

5 (1) in the section heading, by inserting “**OR**
6 **RWANDA**” after “**YUGOSLAVIA**”;

7 (2) in subsection (a)(2), by inserting “or the
8 International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda” after
9 “Yugoslavia”; and

10 (3) in subsection (c)—

11 (A) by inserting “(1)” immediately after
12 “REFERENCE.—”; and

13 (B) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(2) For the purposes of subsection (a), the statute
15 of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda means
16 the statute contained in the annex to Security Council
17 Resolution 955 of November 8, 1994.”.
