1 SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF REWARDS PROGRAM TO IN-2 **CLUDE RWANDA.** 3 Section 102 of the Act of October 30, 1998 (Public 4 Law 105–323) is amended— 5 (1) in the section heading, by inserting "**OR** 6 **RWANDA**" after "YUGOSLAVIA"; (2) in subsection (a)(2), by inserting "or the 7 International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda" after 8 "Yugoslavia"; and 9 10 (3) in subsection (c)— (A) by inserting "(1)" immediately after 11 "REFERENCE.—"; and 12 13 (B) by adding at the end the following: 14 "(2) For the purposes of subsection (a), the statute of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda means 15 16 the statute contained in the annex to Security Council Resolution 955 of November 8, 1994.". 17
