- To amend the Public Health Service Act to revise the performance standards and certification process for organ procurement organizations.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

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TIFICATION ACT OF 2000. (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following findings: (1) Organ procurement organizations play an important role in the effort to increase organ donation in the United States. (2) The current process for the certification and

9 recertification of organ procurement organizations
10 conducted by the Department of Health and Human
11 Services has created a level of uncertainty that is
12 interfering with the effectiveness of organ procure13 ment organizations in raising the level of organ do14 nation.

(3) The General Accounting Office, the Institute of Medicine, and the Harvard School of Public
Health have identified substantial limitations in the
organ procurement organization certification and recertification process and have recommended changes
in that process.

21 (4) The limitations in the recertification process22 include:

(A) An exclusive reliance on populationbased measures of performance that do not account for the potential in the population for
organ donation and do not permit consideration

of other outcome and process standards that would more accurately reflect the relative capability and performance of each organ procurement organization. (B) A lack of due process to appeal to the

Secretary of Health and Human Services for recertification on either substantive or procedural grounds.

9 (5) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv-10 ices has the authority under section 1138(b)(1)(A)(i)11 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b-12 8(b)(1)(A)(i) to extend the period for recertification 13 of an organ procurement organization from 2 to 4 14 vears on the basis of its past practices in order to 15 avoid the inappropriate disruption of the nation's 16 organ system.

17 (6) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv18 ices can use the extended period described in para19 graph (5) for recertification of all organ procure20 ment organizations to—

21 (A) develop improved performance meas22 ures that would reflect organ donor potential
23 and interim outcomes, and to test these meas24 ures to ensure that they accurately measure
