## A BILL

To designate the Washington Opera in Washington, D.C.,  
as the National Opera.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Washington Opera, organized under the laws of  
5 the District of Columbia, is designated as the “National  
6 Opera”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Wash-

1 ington Opera referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to  
2 be a reference to the “National Opera”.
