AN ACT

To authorize the establishment of a disaster mitigation pilot program in the Small Business Administration.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. DISASTER MITIGATION PILOT PROGRAM.

- 2 (a) In General.—Section 7(b)(1) of the Small Busi-
- 3 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 636(b)(1)) is amended—
- 4 (1) in subparagraph (B), by adding "and" at
- 5 the end; and
- 6 (2) by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "(C) during fiscal years 2000 through 2004, to
- 8 establish a predisaster mitigation program to make
- 9 such loans (either directly or in cooperation with
- banks or other lending institutions through agree-
- ments to participate on an immediate or deferred
- 12 (guaranteed) basis), as the Administrator may deter-
- mine to be necessary or appropriate, to enable small
- businesses to use mitigation techniques in support of
- a formal mitigation program established by the Fed-
- eral Emergency Management Agency, except that no
- loan or guarantee may be extended to a small busi-
- 18 ness under this subparagraph unless the Administra-
- 19 tion finds that the small business is otherwise unable
- 20 to obtain credit for the purposes described in this
- subparagraph;".
- 22 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
- 23 20 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631 note) is
- 24 amended by adding at the end the following:

1	"(f) DISASTER MITIGATION PILOT PROGRAM.—The
2	following program levels are authorized for loans under
3	section $7(b)(1)(C)$:
4	"(1) $$15,000,000$ for fiscal year 2000.
5	"(2) $$15,000,000$ for fiscal year 2001.
6	"(3) $$15,000,000$ for fiscal year 2002.
7	"(4) $$15,000,000$ for fiscal year 2003.
8	"(5) $$15,000,000$ for fiscal year 2004.".
9	(c) EVALUATION.—On January 31, 2003, the Admin-
10	istrator of the Small Business Administration shall submit
11	to the Committees on Small Business of the House of Rep-
12	resentatives and the Senate a report on the effectiveness
13	of the pilot program authorized by section 7(b)(1)(C) of
14	the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(b)(1)(C)), as
15	added by subsection (a) of this section, which report shall
16	include—
17	(1) information relating to—
18	(A) the areas served under the pilot pro-
19	gram;
20	(B) the number and dollar value of loans
21	made under the pilot program; and
22	(C) the estimated savings to the Federal
23	Government resulting from the pilot program;
24	and

(2) such other information as the Administrator 1 2 determines to be appropriate for evaluating the pilot 3 program. Passed the Senate March 25, 1999.
