 acres, more or less, and assorted uninhabitable buildings
 and improvements.

8 (b) USE.—The conveyance of the property under sub-9 section (a) shall be subject to reversion to the United 10 States if the property is used for a purpose other than 11 the purpose of a senior assisted living center or a related 12 public purpose.
