#### **AN ACT**

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to complete a land exchange with Georgia Power Company.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- $2\ \ tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled,$
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Lake Oconee Land
- 5 Exchange Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. LAKE OCONEE LAND EXCHANGE.

2	(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
3	(1) Description of the boundary.—The
4	term "description of the boundary" means the docu-
5	ments entitled "Description of the Boundary" dated
6	September 6, 1996, prepared by the Forest Service
7	and on file with the Secretary.
8	(2) Exchange agreement.—The term "ex-
9	change agreement" means the agreement between
10	Georgia Power Company and the Forest Service
11	dated December 26, 1996, as amended on August
12	17, 1998, on file with the Secretary.
13	(3) Georgia Power Company.—The term
14	"Georgia Power Company" means Georgia Power
15	Company, a division of the Southern Company, a
16	Georgia corporation, or its successors or assigns.
17	(4) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
18	the Secretary of Agriculture.
19	(b) Land Exchange.—
20	(1) In general.—Simultaneously with convey-
21	ance by Georgia Power Company to the Secretary of
22	all right, title, and interest in and to the land de-
23	scribed in paragraph (2), the Secretary shall—
24	(A) convey to Georgia Power Company all
25	right, title, and interest in and to the land de-

- scribed in paragraph (3), except as provided in the exchange agreement; and
- 3 (B) make a value equalization payment of 4 \$23,250 to Georgia Power Company.
  - (2) Land to be conveyed to the sec-RETARY.—The land described in this paragraph is the land within or near the Chattahoochee National Forest and Oconee National Forest in the State of Georgia, comprising approximately 1,175.46 acres, described in the exchange agreement and the description of the boundary.
    - (3) Land to be conveyed to georgia Power company.—The land described in this paragraph is the land in the State of Georgia, comprising approximately 1,275.80 acres, described in the exchange agreement and the description of the boundary.

#### (c) Partial Revocation of Withdrawals.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—The orders issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission under section 24 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 818), authorizing Power Project Numbers 2413 and 2354, issued August 6, 1969, and October 1, 1996, respectively, are revoked insofar as the orders affect the land described in subsection (b)(3).

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1	(2) No annual charge.—No interest con-
2	veyed to Georgia Power Company or easement right
3	retained by Georgia Power Company under this sec-
4	tion shall be subject to an annual charge for the
5	purpose of compensating the United States for the
6	use of its land for power purposes.
