A BILL

To require the Department of Agriculture to establish an electronic filing and retrieval system to enable the public to file all required paperwork electronically with the Department and to have access to public information on farm programs, quarterly trade, economic, and production reports, and other similar information.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Freedom to E-File
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELECTRONIC FILING AND RETRIEVAL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
3 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture
4 shall establish an electronic filing and retrieval system to
5 enable the public to file all required paperwork electroni-
6 cally with the Department of Agriculture and to have ac-
7 cess to public information on farm programs, quarterly
8 trade, economic, and production reports, and other similar
9 information.

10 (b) PROGRESS REPORTS.—Not later than 90 days
11 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
12 report to Congress on the progress made toward imple-
13 menting subsection (a).
