Mr. DURBIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Corina Dechalup.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Corina Dechalup shall be held and consid-
7 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States
8 for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment
9 of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Corina
12 Dechalup, as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State

1 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the appro-
2 priate number during the current fiscal year the total
3 number of immigrant visas available to natives of the
4 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the
5 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
