## A BILL

To eliminate restrictions on the acquisition of certain land contiguous to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Hawaii Volcanoes Na-  
5 tional Park Adjustment Act of 1999”.

**6 SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF RESTRICTIONS ON LAND ACQUI-  
7 TION.**

8       The first section of the Act entitled “An Act to add  
9 certain lands on the island of Hawaii to the Hawaii Na-

1 tional Park, and for other purposes”, approved June 20,  
2 1938 (16 U.S.C. 391b), is amended by striking “park:  
3 *Provided*,” and all that follows and inserting “park. Land  
4 (including the land depicted on the map entitled ‘NPS–  
5 PAC 1997HW’) may be acquired by the Secretary through  
6 donation, exchange, or purchase with donated or appro-  
7 priated funds.”.
