- 1 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
- 2 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
- 3 when the House adjourns on the legislative day of Thurs-
- 4 day, June 29, 2000, or Friday, June 30, 2000, on a mo-
- 5 tion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its
- 6 Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until
- 7 12:30 p.m. on Monday, July 10, 2000, for morning-hour
- 8 debate, or until noon on the second day after Members
- 9 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this con-
- 10 current resolution, whichever occurs first.
- 11 Sec. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
- 12 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
- 13 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
- 14 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
- 15 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
- 16 this opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
