concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To make technical corrections in the enrollment of the bill
H.R. 3676.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 3676)
3 to establish the Santa Rosa and San Jacinto Mountains
4 National Monument in the State of California, the Clerk
5 of the House of Representatives shall make the following
6 corrections:

7 (1) In the second sentence of section 2(d)(1),
8 strike “and the Committee on Agriculture, Nutri-
9 tion, and Forestry”.

1 (2) In the second sentence of section 4(a)(3),
2 strike “Nothing in this section” and insert “Nothing
3 in this Act”.

4 (3) In section 4(c)(1), strike “any person, in-
5 cluding”.

6 (4) In section 5, add at the end the following:
7 “(j) WILDERNESS PROTECTION.—Nothing in this
8 Act alters the management of any areas designated as
9 Wilderness which are within the boundaries of the Na-
10 tional Monument. All such areas shall remain subject to
11 the Wilderness Act (16 U.S.C. 1131 et seq.), the laws des-
12 ignating such areas as Wilderness, and other applicable
13 laws. If any part of this Act conflicts with any provision
14 of those laws with respect to the management of the Wil-
15 derness areas, such provisions shall control.”.
