## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To correct the enrollment of H.R. 3244.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2       *concurring)*, That the Clerk of the House of Representa-  
3       tives, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 3244) to combat  
4       trafficking of persons, especially into the sex trade, slav-  
5       ery, and slavery-like conditions, in the United States and  
6       countries around the world through prevention, through  
7       prosecution and enforcement against traffickers, and  
8       through protection and assistance to victims of trafficking,  
9       shall make the following correction:

10               (1) In section 2002(a)(2)(A)(ii), strike “June 7,  
11       1999,” and insert “December 13, 1999,”.
