## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

To correct the enrollment of H.R. 3244.

1 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives concurring), That the Clerk of the House of Representa-3 tives, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 3244) to combat trafficking of persons, especially into the sex trade, slav-5 ery, and slavery-like conditions, in the United States and 6 countries around the world through prevention, through prosecution and enforcement against traffickers, and 8 through protection and assistance to victims of trafficking, 9 shall make the following correction: (1) In section 2002(a)(2)(A)(ii), strike "June 7, 10

1999," and insert "December 13, 1999,".
