## RESOLUTION

To authorize documentary production by the Select  
Committee on Intelligence.

Whereas the Federal Bureau of Investigation has requested that the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence provide it with a certified copy of the testimony of former Director of Central Intelligence John M. Deutch during its closed February 22, 2000 hearing, in connection with a pending inquiry into the alleged improper handling of classified information by Mr. Deutch;

Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States and Rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate can, by the administrative or judicial process, be taken from such control or possession but by permission of the Senate; and

Whereas, when it appears that documents, papers, and records under the control or in the possession of the Senate may promote the administration of justice, the Senate will take such action as will promote the ends of justice consistently with the privileges of the Senate: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman of  
2 the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, acting joint-  
3 ly, are authorized to provide to the Federal Bureau of In-  
4 vestigation, under appropriate security procedures, a cer-  
5 tified copy of the transcript of its closed February 22,  
6 2000 hearing.
