REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 234]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 234, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for the consideration of the Conference Report to accompany H.R. 775, the “Y2K Act.” The rule waives points of order against the conference report and its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report be considered as read.

The waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 8 of House rule XXII (requiring a three-day layover of a conference report) because the conference report was not filed until Tuesday, June 29, and may be considered by the full House as early as Thursday, July 1, 1999.
