

WAIVING POINTS OF ORDER AGAINST THE CONFERENCE REPORT TO ACCOMPANY H.R. 2684, DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS AND HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT, AND INDEPENDENT AGENCIES APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2000

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 328]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 328, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 2684, the Department of Veterans Affairs and Housing and Urban Development, and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 2000, and against its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report shall be considered as read. Finally, section 2 of the resolution provides that House Resolution 300 is laid on the table.

The waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 8 of rule XXII (requiring a three-day layover of a conference report) because the conference report was not made available until Wednesday, October 13, and may be considered as early as Thursday, October 14. Also, the waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 9 of rule XXII (prohibiting matters not specifically committed to the conference from being included in the conference report).
