An Act

Dec. 6, 1999  
[H.R. 1327]

To designate the United States Postal Service building located at 34480 Highway 101 South in Cloverdale, Oregon, as the “Maurine B. Neuberger United States Post Office”.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

The United States Postal Service building located at 34480 Highway 101 South in Cloverdale, Oregon, shall be known and designated as the “Maurine B. Neuberger United States Post Office”.

**SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

Any reference in any law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United States to the United States Postal Service building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Maurine B. Neuberger United States Post Office”.
