## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Expressing the sense of Congress regarding the establishment of Million Mom March Day.

- Whereas 10 children die each day in the United States from gunfire;
- Whereas additional Federal regulation is needed regarding handgun training, education, and design;
- Whereas the Million Mom March has helped raise awareness of the need for further regulation of handguns;
- Whereas a day should be established to pay tribute to the victims of gun trauma and to celebrate the Million Mom March; and

Whereas Mother's Day, May 13, 2001, would be an appropriate day to establish as Million Mom March Day: Now, therefore, be it

- 1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate 2 concurring), That it is the sense of Congress that—
- (1) a Million Mom March Day should be established to pay tribute to the victims of gun trauma
  and to celebrate the Million Mom March; and
- 6 (2) the President should issue a proclamation 7 calling upon the people of the United States to ob-8 serve such a day with appropriate programs and ac-9 tivities.
