Mrs. MCCARTHY of New York (for herself and Ms. NORTON) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Government Reform

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress regarding the
establishment of Million Mom March Day.

Whereas 10 children die each day in the United States from
gunfire;

Whereas additional Federal regulation is needed regarding
handgun training, education, and design;

Whereas the Million Mom March has helped raise awareness
of the need for further regulation of handguns;

Whereas a day should be established to pay tribute to the vic-
tims of gun trauma and to celebrate the Million Mom
March; and

Whereas Mother's Day, May 13, 2001, would be an appropriate day to establish as Million Mom March Day: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that—

3 (1) a Million Mom March Day should be estab-
4 lished to pay tribute to the victims of gun trauma
5 and to celebrate the Million Mom March; and

6 (2) the President should issue a proclamation
7 calling upon the people of the United States to ob-
8 serve such a day with appropriate programs and ac-
9 tivities.
