CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, August 2, 2001, or Friday, August
4 3, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent
5 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand

1 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Wednesday, September 5, 2001,
2 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
3 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
4 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate
5 recesses or adjourns at the close of business on any day
6 from Thursday, August 2, 2001 through Saturday, Au-
7 gust 4, 2001, or from Monday, August 6, 2001, through
8 Saturday, August 11, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant
9 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
10 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on
11 Tuesday, September 4, 2001, or until such time on that
12 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-
13 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon
14 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
15 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
16 whichever occurs first.

17 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
18 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
19 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
20 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House

1 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
2 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
