- 3 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
- 4 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate
- 5 recesses or adjourns at the close of business on any day
- 6 from Thursday, August 2, 2001 through Saturday, Au-
- 7 gust 4, 2001, or from Monday, August 6, 2001, through
- 8 Saturday, August 11, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant
- 9 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
- 10 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on
- 11 Tuesday, September 4, 2001, or until such time on that
- 12 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-
- 13 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon
- 14 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
- 15 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
- 16 whichever occurs first.
- 17 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 18 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
- 19 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
- 20 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House

- 1 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
- 2 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
