3 SECTION 1. RESTRICTION ON RELINQUISHMENT OF LEASE.

Prior to January 1, 2003, the Secretary of the Interior shall not approve the relinquishment of any lease entered into for the establishment of a health care facility
for the members of 7 Indian tribes or bands in San Diego
County, California, unless the Secretary has determined
that the relinquishment of such lease has been approved,

1 by tribal resolution, by each of the 7 Indian tribes or

2 bands.
