AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to increase the amount of educational benefits for veterans under the Montgomery GI Bill.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “21st Century Mont-
3 gomery GI Bill Enhancement Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN RATES OF BASIC EDUCATIONAL AS-**
5 **SISTANCE UNDER MONTGOMERY GI BILL.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Section 3015(a)(1) of title 38,
7 United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 “(1) for an approved program of education pur-
9 sued on a full-time basis, at the monthly rate of—

10 “(A) for months occurring during fiscal
11 year 2002, \$800,

12 “(B) for months occurring during fiscal
13 year 2003, \$950,

14 “(C) for months occurring during fiscal
15 year 2004, \$1,100, and

16 “(D) for months occurring during a subse-
17 quent fiscal year, the amount for months occur-
18 ring during the previous fiscal year increased
19 under subsection (h); or”.

20 (2) Section 3015(b)(1) of such title is amended to
21 read as follows:

22 “(1) for an approved program of education pur-
23 sued on a full-time basis, at the monthly rate of—

24 “(A) for months occurring during fiscal
25 year 2002, \$650,

1 “(B) for months occurring during fiscal
2 year 2003, \$772,

3 “(C) for months occurring during fiscal
4 year 2004, \$894, and

5 “(D) for months occurring during a subse-
6 quent fiscal year, the amount for months occur-
7 ring during the previous fiscal year increased
8 under subsection (h); or”.

9 (b) CPI ADJUSTMENT.—No adjustment in rates of
10 educational assistance shall be made under section
11 3015(h) of title 38, United States Code, for fiscal years
12 2002, 2003, and 2004.
