- To provide grants to local educational agencies that agree to begin school for secondary students after 9:00 in the morning.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Z's to A's Act".

5 SEC. 2. PROGRAM AUTHORIZATION.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Education is au7 thorized to provide a grant of not more than \$25,000 to
8 each local educational agency that agrees to begin school
9 for secondary students after 9:00 in the morning.

(b) ELIGIBILITY.—To be eligible to receive a grant
 under this section, a local educational agency shall submit
 an application to the Secretary providing assurances
 that—

5 (1) at the time of the application, secondary
6 schools served by the local educational agency begin
7 school before 9:00 in the morning; and

8 (2) not later than 2 years after the date of sub9 mission of the application, secondary schools served
10 by such agency shall begin classes after 9:00 in the
11 morning.

12 (c) USES OF FUNDS.—A local educational agency 13 that receives a grant under this Act may use such grant 14 funds to pay for the administrative and operating costs 15 associated in changing the hours of operation of secondary 16 schools served by such agency.

17 (d) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this Act—

(1) the term "secondary school" has the same
meaning given such term in section 14101(25) of
the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
1965 (20 U.S.C. 8801(25)); and

(2) the term "Secretary" means the Secretaryof Education.
