A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for Government furnished headstones or markers for the marked graves of veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF GOVERNMENT HEADSTONES**
2 **FOR MARKED GRAVES.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 2306(a) of title 38,
4 United States Code, is amended, in the matter preceding
5 paragraph (1), by striking “appropriate Government
6 headstones or markers at the expense of the United States
7 for the unmarked graves of the following:” and inserting
8 “one appropriate Government headstone or marker at the
9 expense of the United States, other than for replacement,
10 to mark the grave of the following:”.

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
12 subsection (a) applies with respect to applications for Gov-
13 ernment headstones or markers received by the Secretary
14 of Veterans Affairs for individuals dying on or after No-
15 vember 1, 1990.
