RULE WAIVING SECTION 303 IN THE HOUSE OF REP-12 **RESENTATIVES.** 13 Clause 6(c) of rule XIII of the Rules of the House 14 of Representatives is amended by striking the period at the end of subparagraph (2) and inserting a semicolon and 15 16 by adding at the end the following new subparagraph: 17 "(3) a rule or order proposing that section 18 303(a) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 be 19 waived by a vote of less than three-fifths of the 20 Members voting, a quorum being present.".
