A BILL

To clarify the citizenship eligibility for certain members of the Tohono O'odham Nation of Arizona, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR UNITED STATES CITIZEN-
- 4 SHIP; PASS AND REPASS OF BORDERS.
- 5 (a) Applications for Citizenship Granted.—
- 6 For a period of 3 years beginning on the date of the enact-
- 7 ment of this Act, any member of the Tohono O'odham
- 8 Nation of Arizona residing on the lands of the Tohono
- 9 O'odham Nation of Arizona in Arizona or Mexico may
- 10 apply for United States citizenship. Such application shall

- 1 be made to the Immigration and Naturalization Service
- 2 and, upon receipt of the application, citizenship shall be
- 3 granted to the applicant.
- 4 (b) Pass and Repass of Borders.—Notwith-
- 5 standing the Immigration and Nationality Act, all mem-
- 6 bers of the Tohono O'odham Nation of Arizona shall be
- 7 entitled to pass and repass freely the borders of the United
- 8 States.
