- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR
- 4 MID-ATLANTIC OIL AND GAS LEASE SALE.
- 5 The Secretary of the Interior shall not expend any
- 6 funds for the preparation of, or conduct of, preleasing and
- 7 leasing activities (including calls for information, tract se-
- 8 lection, notices of sale, receipt of bids, and award of
- 9 leases) with respect to an oil and gas lease sale on any
- 10 lands of the outer Continental Shelf between the seaward

- 1 boundary between the States of Connecticut and Rhode
- 2 Island and the seaward boundary between the States of
- 3 North Carolina and South Carolina.
