AN ACT

To extend the moratorium enacted by the Internet Tax Freedom Act through November 1, 2003, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Internet Tax Non-
3 discrimination Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF INTERNET TAX FREEDOM ACT MOR-
5 ATORIUM.**

6 Section 1101(a) of the Internet Tax Freedom Act (47
7 U.S.C. 151 note) is amended by striking “3 years after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act” and inserting “on
9 November 1, 2003”.
