## A BILL

To amend section 507 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 to authorize additional appropriations for historically black colleges and universities, to decrease the matching requirement related to such appropriations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DECREASED MATCHING REQUIREMENT; AU-**  
2 **THORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

3 (a) DECREASED MATCHING REQUIREMENT.—Sec-  
4 tion 507(c) of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Man-  
5 agement Act of 1996 (16 U.S.C. 470a note) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “(1) Except” and inserting the  
7 following:

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Except”;

9 (2) by striking “paragraph (2)” and inserting  
10 “paragraphs (2) and (3)”;

11 (3) by striking “(2) The Secretary” and insert-  
12 ing the following:

13 “(2) WAIVER.—The Secretary”;

14 (4) by striking “paragraph (1)” and inserting  
15 “paragraphs (1) and (3)”;

16 (5) by adding at the end the following new  
17 paragraph:

18 “(3) EXCEPTION.—The Secretary may obligate  
19 funds made available under subsection (d)(2) for a  
20 grant with respect to a building or structure listed  
21 on, or eligible for listing on, the National Register  
22 of Historic Places only if the grantee agrees to pro-  
23 vide, from funds derived from non-Federal sources,  
24 an amount that is equal to 30 percent of the total  
25 cost of the project for which the grant is provided.”.

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATION.—Section  
2 507(d) of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Manage-  
3 ment Act of 1996 (16 U.S.C. 470a note) is amended—

4 (1) by striking “Pursuant to” and inserting the  
5 following:

6 “(1) 1996 AUTHORIZATION.—Pursuant to”;

7 and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following new  
9 paragraph:

10 “(2) ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZATION.—In addi-  
11 tion to amounts made available under paragraph  
12 (1), pursuant to section 108 of the National Historic  
13 Preservation Act, there is authorized to be appro-  
14 priated \$530,000,000 to carry out the purposes of  
15 this section.”.
