AN ACT

To amend section 507 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 to authorize additional appropriations for historically black colleges and universities, to decrease the matching requirement related to such appropriations, and for other purposes.

8	(a) Decreased Matching Requirement.—Sec-
9	tion 507(c) of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Man-

14	"(1) In general.—Except as provided in para-
15	graph (2), the Secretary may obligate funds made
16	available under subsection (d) for a grant with re-

18	for listing on, the National Register of Historic
19	Places only if the grantee agrees to provide, from
20	funds derived from non-Federal sources, an amount
21	that is equal to 30 percent of the total cost of the

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section 2 507(d) of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 (16 U.S.C. 470a note) is amended— 3 4 (1) by striking "Pursuant to" and inserting the 5 following: 1996 AUTHORIZATION.—Pursuant to"; 6 "(1) 7 and 8 (2) by adding at the end the following new paragraph: 9 10 "(2) Additional authorization.—In addi-11 tion to amounts made available under paragraph 12 (1), pursuant to section 108 of the National Historic 13 Preservation Act, there is authorized to be appro-14 priated such sums as may be necessary to carry out 15 the purposes of this section.". 16 APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.—Subsection (c)(1) of section 507 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996, as amended by sub-18 19 section (a), shall apply with respect to— 20 (1) funds made available under subsection 21 (d)(2) of such section, as added by subsection (b); 22 and 23 funds made available under subsection
