## AN ACT

To amend the Taxpayer Relief Act of 1997 to provide for consistent treatment of survivor benefits for public safety officers killed in the line of duty.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Fallen Hero Survivor  
3 Benefit Fairness Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. CONSISTENT TREATMENT OF SURVIVOR BENEFITS**  
5                   **FOR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS KILLED IN**  
6                   **THE LINE OF DUTY.**

7       Subsection (b) of section 1528 of the Taxpayer Relief  
8 Act of 1997 (Public Law 105–34) is amended by striking  
9 the period and inserting “, and to amounts received in  
10 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2001, with re-  
11 spect to individuals dying on or before December 31,  
12 1996.”.
