- 3 SECTION 1. URBAN PARK AND RECREATION RECOVERY
- 4 PROGRAM GRANT FOR NONPROFIT YOUNGS-
- 5 TOWN PLAYHOUSE OF YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO.
- 6 (a) Grant Authority.—Using funds appropriated
- 7 or otherwise made available to carry out the Urban Park
- 8 and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 2501
- 9 et seq.) for fiscal years 2002 through 2006, the Secretary

- 1 of Interior shall make a grant in each of such fiscal years
- 2 to the nonprofit Youngstown Playhouse of Youngstown,
- 3 Ohio, to assist the grant recipient to develop a Millennium
- 4 Cultural Cooperative Park in Youngstown, Ohio. The
- 5 amount of the grant for a fiscal year shall be equal to
- 6 \$2,000,000.
- 7 (b) Technical Assistance.—The Secretary, acting
- 8 through the National Park Service, shall provide technical
- 9 assistance to the grant recipient in developing this unique
- 10 type of urban park.
