3 **SECTION 1. M. CALDWELL BUTLER POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States

5 Postal Service located at 419 Rutherford Avenue, N.E.,

6 in Roanoke, Virginia, shall be known and designated as

7 the “M. Caldwell Butler Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the M. Caldwell Butler
5 Post Office Building.
