A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP REQUIRE-**
4 **MENT FOR EXEMPTION FROM TAX FOR VET-**
5 **ERANS' ORGANIZATIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
7 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating

1 to list of exempt organizations) is amended by striking “or
2 widowers” and inserting “, widowers, or ancestors or lineal
3 descendants”.

4 (b) MODIFICATION NOT TO APPLY IN DETERMINING
5 UNRELATED BUSINESS TAXABLE INCOME.—Paragraph
6 (4) of section 512(a) of such Code is amended by striking
7 “members of such organization or their dependents” and
8 inserting “members of such organization who are past or
9 present members of the Armed Forces of the United
10 States or who are dependents of such past or present
11 members”.

12 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
13 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
14 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
