Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

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## A BILL

To amend section 313 of the Tariff Act of 1930 to make certain products eligible for drawback and to simplify and clarify certain drawback provisions.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. UNUSED MERCHANDISE DRAWBACK.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 313(j) of the Tariff Act  
5 of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 131(3j)) is amended—

6               (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “because of  
7 its” and inserting “upon entry or”;

8               (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “because of  
9 its” and inserting “upon entry or”; and

1           (3) by adding at the end the following new  
2 paragraph:

3           “(5) No prior notification of intent to export is  
4 required to be provided to the Customs Service for  
5 any exports under this subsection.”.

6           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
7 this section shall take effect on the date of enactment of  
8 this Act, and shall apply to any drawback claim filed on  
9 or after that date and to any drawback entry filed before  
10 that date if the liquidation of the entry is not final on  
11 that date.

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
