3 **SECTION 1. D. FRENCH SLAUGHTER POST OFFICE BUILD-**
4 **ING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 205 South Main Street in Cul-
7 pepper, Virginia, shall be known and designated as the
8 “D. French Slaughter Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the D. French Slaughter
5 Post Office Building.
