A BILL

To provide a grant under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 to assist in the development of a Millennium Cultural Cooperative Park in Youngstown, Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND ACT**

4 **GRANT FOR NONPROFIT YOUNGSTOWN PLAY-**

5 **HOUSE OF YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO.**

6 (a) GRANT AUTHORITY.—During each of the fiscal
7 years 2002 through 2006, the Secretary of the Interior
8 is authorized to use the land and water conservation fund

1 established under section 2 of the Land and Water Con-
2 servation Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460l–5) to make
3 a grant to the nonprofit Youngstown Playhouse of
4 Youngstown, Ohio, to assist the grant recipient to develop
5 a Millennium Cultural Cooperative Park in Youngstown,
6 Ohio. The amount of the grant for a fiscal year shall be
7 equal to \$2,000,000.

8 (b) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary, acting
9 through the National Park Service, shall provide technical
10 assistance to the grant recipient in developing this unique
11 type of urban park.
