- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND ACT
- 4 GRANT FOR NONPROFIT YOUNGSTOWN PLAY-
- 5 HOUSE OF YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO.
- 6 (a) Grant Authority.—During each of the fiscal
- 7 years 2002 through 2006, the Secretary of the Interior
- 8 is authorized to use the land and water conservation fund

- 1 established under section 2 of the Land and Water Con-
- 2 servation Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460*l*–5) to make
- 3 a grant to the nonprofit Youngstown Playhouse of
- 4 Youngstown, Ohio, to assist the grant recipient to develop
- 5 a Millennium Cultural Cooperative Park in Youngstown,
- 6 Ohio. The amount of the grant for a fiscal year shall be
- 7 equal to \$2,000,000.
- 8 (b) Technical Assistance.—The Secretary, acting
- 9 through the National Park Service, shall provide technical
- 10 assistance to the grant recipient in developing this unique
- 11 type of urban park.
