SHORT TITLE.** 4 This Act may be cited as the "Metacomet-Monad-5 nock-Mattabesett Trail Study Act of 2001". 6 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF **METACOMET-MONADNOCK-**7 MATTABESETT TRAIL FOR STUDY FOR PO-8 **TENTIAL** ADDITION TO THE NATIONAL 9 TRAILS SYSTEM. 10 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16) U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-11 12 lowing new paragraph: 13 "( METACOMET-MONADNOCK-MATTABESETT ) 14 TRAIL.—The Metacomet-Monadnock-Mattabesett Trail, a 15 system of trails and potential trails extending southward approximately 180 miles through western Massachusetts 16 17 on the Metacomet-Monadnock Trail, across central Connecticut on the Metacomet Trail and the Mattabesett 18 19 Trail, and ending at Long Island Sound.". 20SEC. 3. EXPEDITED REPORT TO CONGRESS.

the Secretary of the Interior shall submit the study required by the amendment made by section 2 to Congress
