A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to designate the Metacomet-Monadnock-Sunapee-Mattabesett Trail extending through western New Hampshire, western Mas-

sachusetts, and central Connecticut for study for potential addition to the National Trails System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Metacomet-Monadnock-*
 5 *Mattabesett Trail Study Act of 2001”.*

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF METACOMET-MONADNOCK-**
 7 **MATTABESETT TRAIL FOR STUDY FOR POTEN-**
 8 **TIAL ADDITION TO THE NATIONAL TRAILS**
 9 **SYSTEM.**

10 *Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16*
 11 *U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-*
 12 *lowing new paragraph:*

13 *“(_____) METACOMET-MONADNOCK-MATTABESETT*
 14 *TRAIL.—The Metacomet-Monadnock-Mattabesett Trail, a*
 15 *system of trails and potential trails extending southward*
 16 *approximately 180 miles through western Massachusetts on*
 17 *the Metacomet-Monadnock Trail, across central Connecticut*
 18 *on the Metacomet Trail and the Mattabesett Trail, and end-*
 19 *ing at Long Island Sound.”.*

20 **SEC. 3. EXPEDITED REPORT TO CONGRESS.**

21 *Notwithstanding the fourth sentence of section 5(b) of*
 22 *the National Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(b)), the*
 23 *Secretary of the Interior shall submit the study required*

- 1 *by the amendment made by section 2 to Congress not later*
- 2 *than two years after the date of the enactment of this Act.*

Amend the long title so as to read: “A bill to amend the National Trails System Act to designate the Metacomet-Monadnock-Mattabesett Trail extending through western Massachusetts and central Connecticut for study for potential addition to the National Trails System.”.
