A BILL

To extend eligibility for refugee status of unmarried sons
and daughters of certain Vietnamese refugees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR REFUGEE STATUS.**

4 Section 255 of the Admiral James W. Nance and
5 Meg Donovan Foreign Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal
6 Years 2000 and 2001 (section 255 of division A of H.R.
7 3427, as enacted into law by section 1000(a)(7) of Public
8 Law 106–113, appendix G; 113 Stat. 1501A–460) is
9 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “and 2001,”
2 and inserting “2001, 2002, and 2003,”;

3 (2) in subsection (c)(2)(B), by striking “except
4 as provided in subsection (d), on or after April 1,
5 1995,”; and

6 (3) by striking subsection (d).
