# 3 SECTION 1. APPEALS IN INTER PARTES REEXAMINATION 4 PROCEEDINGS.

5 (a) APPEALS BY THIRD-PARTY REQUESTER IN PRO6 CEEDINGS.—Section 315(b) of title 35, United States
7 Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 "(b) THIRD-PARTY REQUESTER.—A third-party9 requester—

"(1) may appeal under the provisions of section
134, and may appeal under the provisions of sections 141 through 144, with respect to any final decision favorable to the patentability of any original
or proposed amended or new claim of the patent;
and

7 "(2) may, subject to subsection (c), be a party
8 to any appeal taken by the patent owner under the
9 provisions of section 134 or sections 141 through
10 144.".

(b) APPEAL TO BOARD OF PATENT APPEALS AND
INTERFERENCES.—Section 134(c) of title 35, United
States Code, is amended by striking the last sentence.

(c) APPEAL TO COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE FED15 ERAL CIRCUIT.—Section 141 of title 35, United States
16 Code, is amended in the third sentence by inserting ", or
17 a third-party requester in an inter partes reexamination
18 proceeding, who is" after "patent owner".

#### 19 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The amendments made by this Act apply with respect
to any reexamination proceeding commenced on or after
the date of the enactment of this Act.
